The intense aspect of unhurried tranquility immediately brings your attention to the Red Stelvio Crianza. The deep redness of this wine resembles a garnet braced in chestnut tones. As you tilt the glass towards your mouth, the fruity raspberry aroma captures your senses. Upon indulging the wine, the aroma fluctuates to toasted honey and then to a plum scent. The aroma finally concludes with gentle scents of chocolate and coconut. The smooth entry of the Red Stelvio to the palate is followed by a well-balanced and edgeless flow. Even the faintest sip of this wine finishes with
